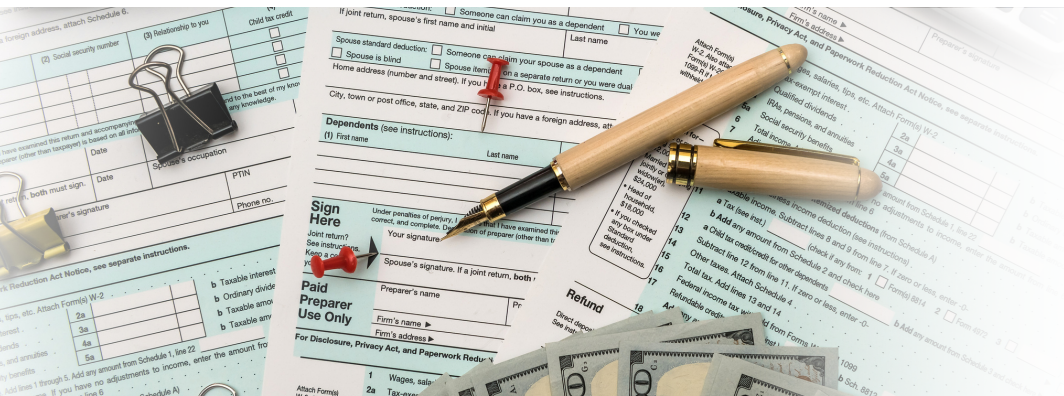
If no sessions have commenced, a 100% refund of the upfront payment is possible upon written request.
